· **Hazard description:**

· **Information concerning particular hazards for human and environment:**

The product has to be labelled due to the calculation procedure of the "General Classification guideline for preparations of the EU" in the latest valid version.

4 First aid measures

- **After inhalation:**
Supply fresh air; consult doctor in case of complaints.
Take affected persons into fresh air and keep quiet.
- **After skin contact:**
Immediately wash with water and soap and rinse thoroughly.
Immediately remove any clothing soiled by the product.
- **After eye contact:**
Rinse opened eye for several minutes under running water. If symptoms persist, consult a doctor.
- **After swallowing:** Do not induce vomiting; call for medical help immediately.

5 Fire-fighting measures

- **Suitable extinguishing agents:**
Foam
Fire-extinguishing powder
Carbon dioxide
- **For safety reasons unsuitable extinguishing agents:** Water with full jet
- **Special hazards caused by the substance, its products of combustion or resulting gases:**
Can form explosive gas-air mixtures.
