1. Identification of the product

Product: Flashing strip. A waterproof building barrier strip

2. Hazard identification

The product is a laminate of:-

(i)	A lacquered aluminium foil
(ii)	A self adhesive rubber modified bitumen compound
(iii)	A silicone coated release interleave
